Let us remember that widow, who forgetting herself for love of the poor poured out all that she had to live, thinking only of the future, as the judge himself declared. The others in fact-said the Lord-"have given of their superfluous;" she instead, perhaps more needy than many poor people, so much so that two small coins was all her possessions, but generous of soul more than all the rich, because she aspired uniquely for the riches of the eternal reward, and avid only, for herself, for the heavenly treasures, renounced to all the goods which come from the earth and to the earth return.

She offered all that she had in order to possess the invisible goods. She put that which is corruptible in order to gain that which is immortal. That poor woman did not despise the norms established by God with regard to the conquest of the future reward; therefore the legislator himself did not forget her, on the contrary the judge of the world anticipated her sentence and announced in advance in the gospel that she would be crowned on the day of judgement.
