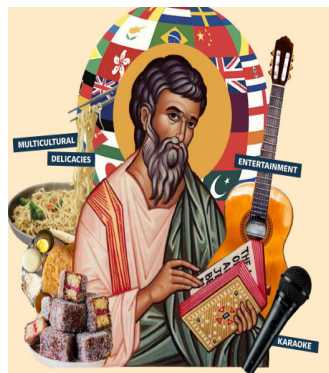


Annual Catholic Campaign envelopes.
