New Volunteer requirements.

Mid July, the Archdiocese changed the requirements for having a Blue Card and a Police check.

A number of volunteer roles that previously required registration and/ or particular compliance requirements have been removed and some compliance requirements have changed for the remaining roles. To align our records, we had to reclassify and update the Parish's roles recently.

Roles such as Readers, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (Mass), collectors, and Hospitality no longer require registration.

Some volunteers may have already received a delink message from Blue Card services. However, their cards and police checks (if they got one) will remain valid until their card expire. We will not renew these cards, unless the volunteer moves into a new role requiring one. *Fr Richard.*
