Explanation of our Liturgical Years.

Each year, the Church begins a new liturgical year commencing in Advent (Years A, B and C). These years rotate thought out each calendar year. Each liturgical year contains four important cycles, which are: Advent, Ordinary

Time, Lent/Easter and Extraordinary Times (Solemn Celebrations). We are now commencing an important cycle in Ordinary Time which is when God comes to us <u>always</u>. As Catholics we are required to attend all Masses throughout the year, the term Ordinary does not mean that the liturgical celebrations are less important, the Ordinary Time is the respective preparatory season of Advent and Lent. This year we are aiming for similar scores and are currently checking each volunteer's record who need renewal of Blue Cards, Police Checks and Safeguarding Training.
