Message for Mother's Day.

Pope Francis opened this year by highlighting in his homily for the Jan. 1 feast of Mary, Mother of God, and his Angelus message the same day, the central role women have played in salvation history and that they still have for bringing peace to the world of the 21st century.

In his homily, Pope Francis emphasised the role women play in a world that is suffering from violence and, as he often says, a "third world war" that is being waged "piecemeal."
