Stop the anti-faith Anti-Discrimination Bill



The Queensland Government is currently looking at introducing the Anti-Discrimination Bill 2024. It proposes stringent restrictions on religious freedoms. The Bill would greatly impact the Churches ability to operate in alignment with our faith values.

The bill would significantly restrict the ability of Churches, Schools and other faith organisations to choose who we employ, as well as introducing other harsh restrictions.

The most important thing you can do is to write to your local MP until them you are concerned about the bill.

Politicians will not know that we care about this unless we tell them.

THE SOLEMNITY OF THE Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ Feast of Corpus Christi— extract from FaithND—University of Notre Dame. Today's feast comes after the fulfillment of the promise of Holy Thursday in the Easter season and Pentecost. We honoured the Holy Trinity last week, and now we celebrate the gift of the Eu-

charist as the means by which the divine life of the Trinity saves us and makes us holy. In fact, the word *Eucharist* literally means "thanksgiving."

Our belief in the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist begins with the words of Jesus himself. In the sixth chapter of the Gospel of John, Jesus identifies himself as the bread of life and says that "unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you."

The word that Jesus uses when he says that whoever "eats" his flesh couldn't get more literal. In the original Greek, that word means to "munch" or "gnaw" and refers to the physical process of chewing food.
