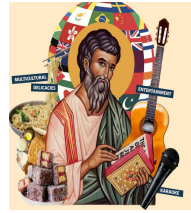

Save the date for St Matthew's Feast Celebration.



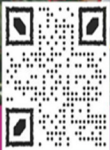
We will celebrate our Multicultural Mass and St Matthew's Feast on
