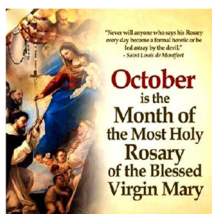
## **26th Sunday in Ordinary Time.**

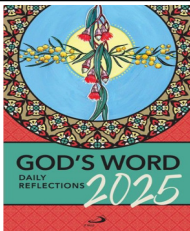

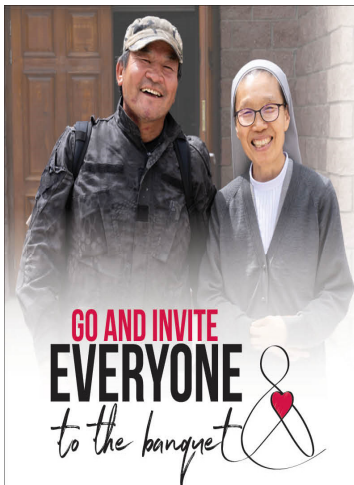
